Emergency Exercises

Once a plan is written, it must be tested. Whether it is the Emergency Operating Center (EOC) or a business unit, an untested plan is a liability. Exercises consist of the performance of duties, tasks, or operations very similar to the way they would be performed in a real-life emergency. An exercise can test or evaluate emergency operation plans, procedures or facilities. The exercise can be as simple as a tabletop activity or as complete as a full-scale emergency exercise with professional video and audio enhanced simulation.

High-Rise Fire Safety Plans

As noted in the California Code of Regulations, Title 19, Section 3.09, office buildings of two or more stories in height and all high-rise office buildings must have a fire safety plan. This includes detailed emergency procedures information, building descriptions, team duties, and annual fire drills. Our plans meet local fire authorities requirements.

Emergency Procedures Manuals

The first part of any emergency response program is to know what to do in any emergency.
